- What has been your greatest blessing this past week?

Read Acts 17:1-9

- What city does Paul minister in next?
 - How far was this city from Philippi?
 - How long did it take Paul to travel there from Philippi?
 - What does this say about Paul after what happened to him in Philippi?
- Where does Paul go first to preach?
 - For how long does he do this?
 - What does the word "reason" indicate about Paul's style of communicating?
 - How does this relate to us in 1 Peter 3:15?
 - What can we do today to prepare to be able to do this more effectively?
 - What does Paul use as a basis for his evidence?

- What would have been the Jews hang-up about Jesus according to 1 Corinthians 1:23?

- What is the response to his preaching?
 - Who believes?
 - What do those who do not believe do?
 - What does this teach us about the Gospel?
 - How does this effect you sharing your faith?

Read Acts 17:10-15

- What city does Paul go to next?
 - How does Paul describe them as being different than those who were in the last city?
 - What two things made them "noble-minded"?
 - What keeps you from being more eager to hear, read and study the Bible?
 - What hinders you the most from weighing the evidence Scripturally of everything you hear taught?
- What is the result of Paul's ministry here?
 - Who believes
 - Who is the source of opposition? Where do they come from? What is their motive? What do they do?
 - How does their time in this city end?

Read Acts 16:28-34

- What does Paul assure the jailor? What do you think made the prisoners all stay and not escape?
- What does the jailor ask Paul and Silas? What is their answer?
 - What made the jailor ask this?
 - What does this say about evangelism?
 - Does Paula adding the words “and your household” guarantee that if someone gets saved, everyone in their household will as well? What caused the jailor’s family to put their faith in Christ as well?
