Read Acts 18:1-8

- Who did Paul meet and work with in Corinth?
 - What was their occupation?
 - What would they ultimately do for Paul (Romans 16:3-4)?
 - What does this say about the need for ministry partners?
- Why did Paul change his focus from the Jews to the Gentiles?
 - Who are named as Gentile converts?
 - Who else became Gentile converts (1 Corinthians 1:14-16; 16:15)?

Read Acts 18:9-17

- What appears to be Paul's concern? What appears to be what he is considering due to this concern?
 - What did God command Paul to do in a vision? How are we under a similar command of God today?

- What three promises did God make to Paul in this vision? How does God make similar promises to us today?
- As a result of this command and these promises, how long does Paul stay at Corinth? What does this show us about how we should respond to God's commands and promises today, even in light of fear?
- What principles can we learn from this to be more effective in sharing Christ with others today?
- What do Paul's Jewish opponents do?
 - What is the charge against Paul?
 - Who is the authority that Paul stands before?
 - What verdict does the authority give concerning Paul?
 - Who do the Jews attack as a result? Why?
 - What ultimately happens to this Jewish man (1 Corinthians 1:1-3)?
 - ❖ What does this teach us about the saving power of God?
 - ❖ What does this teach us about those who may oppose us because of our faith?
